Hands-on sessions will be at different sites throughout Northern KY with Day 1 being at the Campbell County Fire Training Center – 10 Fire Training Drive, Cold Springs KY 41076

This 40-hour high intensity course is designed to expand the students working knowledge of rope rescue. Class will be extensively hands-on, covering techniques to meet and exceed the requirements of NFPA 1670(2017) and NFPA 1006(2021).

Student Pre-Requisites: Firefighter or Rescuer with appropriate agency sponsorship to include Worker's Compensation Insurance & Agency Sponsorship Form.

Students will need the following items (compliant to NFPA 1983 and inspected day 1):

- 1) Rope Rescue Harness
- 2) Helmet
- 3) Clean gloves suitable for rope work
- 4) Appropriate dress for the weather, including long pants
- 5) Boots with good tread and ankle support
